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Abs pump accumulator low pressure

I"ve dealt with the abs pump before...will kick on lights, throw low pressure accumulator codes, and lots of squeaking at idle pressing brake or coming to a stop. The one I am in however, has the following 3 codes: ABS/VSC/TRAC: C1252 (Current) - Hydro-Booster Pump Motor ABS/VSC/TRAC: C1256 (Current) - ACCumulator Low Pressure

I was able to disable " vehicle stability enhancement system" (VSES - Stabilitrac) by disconnecting the lead from the " medium pressure accumulator" (MPA) switch and shorting it with a paperclip. This causes the VSES to fail its initial tests and illuminate the " service stability system" message, but the overall ABS remains functional.

To diagnose ABS modulator valve problems, you have to know how they work to apply, hold or release the brakes. Each brake corner has two valves. The inlet/isolation valve isolates the brake corner from the ABS pump/accumulator and the master cylinder. The outlet/dump valve allows brake pressure to be released.

Our 2006 Hybrid Highlander Limited is in otherwise good condition, at 153k miles. But my dashboard lit up with warnings a couple of weeks ago (ABS, brake, check engine, check VSC system).
