

# Ampere storage Solomon Islands

The Solomon Islands Renewable Energy Development Project (SIREDP) is supported with grant funding from the Asian Development Bank (ADB). The project will help Solomon Islands increase the penetration of renewable energy and reduce dependence on imported diesel fuel for ...

The hybrid power system consists of a small wind turbine, a photovoltaic panel, a pumped storage hydroelectricity and energy storage system. The renewable energy hybrid system can provide stable electricity and water to the island without greenhouse gas emission by fossil fuels.

Not only is energy in the country unreliable, it is expensive. Energy in Solomon Islands costs an average of US\$0.58 per kilowatt hour. At this price, a family in Honiara using 250 watts for 8 hours a day would have to pay over US\$1 a day for electricity.

The Solomon Islands is largest island nation in Oceania in terms of land area, and the second largest nation by population (excluding Australia, New Zealand, and Papua New Guinea). It also is the least electrified. Less than 20% of the population of Solomon Islands has access to electricity.

This is the first joint project financing by ADB and SFD. The Government of Solomon Islands is providing \$7 million in exempted duties and taxes. Virtually all of Solomon Islands" grid electricity is diesel generated, with renewables ...

The project will finance new solar farms in Guadalcanal and Malaita province, along with a utility-scale grid-connected energy storage system in Honiara. Nearly all of Solomon Islands" grid power is diesel generated.
