What happened to Genesis & FRV Australia's 63 MW solar farm?

Genesis and joint venture partner, FRV Australia, have begun construction of their 63 MW solar farm at Lauriston on the Canterbury Plains, after reaching financial close in December 2023. A sod-turning ceremony on site on 23 April saw Genesis Chief Executive Malcolm Johns and FRV Australia CEO Carlo Frigerio launch construction.

How will FRV Australia work with Genesis?

FRV Australia will bring its expertise in developing utility-scale solar projects around the world to work with Genesis in delivering up to 500 MW of solar capacity over the next five years. This will generate about 750 GWh pa - enough to power 100,000 households or 185,000 EVs per year.

Will Genesis get 500 MW of solar in 2021?

The announcement follows Genesis securing an advanced stage site in Canterbury for a 60 MW solar farm in February. The combined generation of the four sites - 460 MW - puts the company on track to achieve the target it set in 2021 of securing up to 500 MW of solar within five years.

What is Genesis Energy doing in New Zealand?

It is now able to expand its regional activities to the New Zealand energy market. Genesis Energy is a leader in New Zealand's journey to a low carbon future through an increasingly diverse generation portfolio and its commitment to reduce greenhouse gas emissions.

What is the largest solar farm in New Zealand?

FRV Australia and its joint venture partner, Genesis Energy, have begun the construction of the largest solar farm in New Zealand after reaching financial close in December 2023. The 63 MW solar farm, once operational by the end of 2024, will power the equivalent of nearly 13,000 houses.

What happened at Genesis & FRV Australia's sod-turning ceremony?

A sod-turning ceremony on site on 23 April saw Genesis Chief Executive Malcolm Johns and FRV Australia CEO Carlo Frigerio launch construction. Also in attendance were Ashburton Mayor Neil Brown, the Chief Executive of EA Networks, Onno Mulder, and the General Manager of construction partner BEON, Kieren Lewis.

Genesis Energy and joint venture partner, FRV Australia, have confirmed three new North Island sites for solar farms with 400 MW of renewable electricity capacity. The sites are in the Manawatu, Waikato and Hawke's Bay with an expected capacity of 200 MW, 100 MW and 100 MW respectively.
