

Bamako water storage project progress

How can water supply be improved in Bamako?

Improved water storage and distribution networks, along with increased household connections and standpipes where required, will make it possible to supply water to many unserved areas in Bamako and neighboring communes.

Does Bamako have sewage sludge treatment facilities?

The capital has no regulated sewage sludge treatment facilities, owing in part to the challenges associated with securing sites. The proposed investments are designed to rehabilitate the Noumoubougou landfill to provide the Greater Bamako area with treatment capacity for 20 years.

Does Bamako have a sewage system?

Sewer networks are almost nonexistent in Bamako and 98 percent of the population still relies on on-site sanitation facilities. The capital has no regulated sewage sludge treatment facilities, owing in part to the challenges associated with securing sites.
