This initiative, supported by the ongoing "Emergency Recovery Project 1" of the Sint Maarten Trust Fund, aims to elevate NV GEBE's business and investment strategies, ensuring reliable power delivery across Sint Maarten.

With help from the government, thousands of solar panels, batteries and new wind turbines are being realised on the island. A next step is to set up a so called "Klimaattafel" to make the island sustainable and resilient to the impacts of climate change.

SEC is looking at the options to install one or two wind turbines which should supplement for the lack of sun during the night for charging the batteries. Several locations for a windmill are being studied along the coast line between Fort Bay Harbor and the quarry before the Black Rocks area leading to Giles Quarter.
