What energy sources does Benin have?

Benin has several sources of energy including natural gas and oil. Oil production in the country began in 1982 at the Seme offshore oil field, operated by Saga Petroleum Company. Although the country is not a major producer of oil, this sector has contributed significantly to its foreign earnings.

Who is responsible for generating electricity in Benin?

Societe Beninoise d'Energie Electrique (SBEE) is responsible for generating around 13% of electricity in Benin through diesel generators. ABERME (Agence Beninoise d'Electrification Rurale et de Maitrise d'Energie), on the other hand, is responsible for rural energy supply.

What services do you offer in Benin?

A number of opportunities exist in power generation. As Benin seeks to both increase and diversify its electric power generation capacity, opportunities in thermal, solar, wind, and other generation technologies are increasingly attractive to potential investors.
