Who is Bermuda Electric Light Company?

In the 1950s, we decided against developing a tramway for the island and so removed the word "Traction" from the Company's name and became what we all know today as the Bermuda Electric Light Company Limited - BELCO. We embraced new technologies as we grew.

Why should you choose Bermudian energy?

Today, we remain committed to providing reliable, safe energy to the people of Bermuda, a task dutifully performed by a team of more than 230 staff, of which 95% are Bermudian. The Company provides power to approximately 36,000 metered connections and the Company is working toward a renewable energy future and achieving Net Zero by 2050.

What is Bermuda Electric Light Company (Belco)?

Bermuda Electric Light Company (BELCO) has one primary objective--to supply our customers with safe, reliable, affordable electricity. Our ultimate goal is to become a renewable energy company and we are working steadily towards that goal. My personal commitment to the people of Bermuda--our valued customers--is honest and transparent communication.

When was the first commercial electricity provided in Bermuda?

In May 1907 the Bermuda Electric Light, Power and Traction Company Limited (BELP&T) provided the first commercial electricity to a handful of customers in Hamilton. The Company had been incorporated several years earlier by several prominent Bermudian businessmen.

What is Bermuda's Integrated Resource Plan?

On July 26, 2019, the RA released Bermuda's first Integrated Resource Plan, which outlined the framework for Bermuda's energy requirements over the next 25 years. The IRP aimed to have 85% of Bermuda's power generated by renewable means by 2035.

With regard to Bermuda's current Integrated Resource Plan, Belco is closely evaluating offshore wind as a possible renewable energy solution for Bermuda. In May, during an online forum, Krista Barnes, Belco's director of ...
