

What is Terna doing in Italy?

Terna, which manages the Italian electricity grid, awarded just under 250MW of contracts to provide the Fast Reserve service to the grid a few days ago. It assigned three tranches of contracts, in the Central and Northern regions, in the Centre-South and on the island of Sardinia.

How many GW will Terna spa deliver in 2024?

Italian grid operator Terna SpA (BIT:TRN) on Tuesday assigned contracts for 41.5 GW in the capacity market auction for the 2024 delivery year, including 12.9 GW of awards to energy major Enel SpA (BIT:ENEL). This auction round is the third one, with auctions already held for the delivery years 2022 and 2023.

When will Terna provide a fast reserve frequency regulation?

Clean Horizon pointed out in its analysis that commissioning of projects is expected to take place before the beginning of 2023, and that projects will be called on by Terna to provide the Fast Reserve frequency regulation for 1,000 hours per year from 2023-2027.

What are Terna's new revenue streams?

"Terna is in the process of opening new revenue streams to storage such as primary reserve, secondary reserve and the MSD market (equivalent to the UK's Balancing Mechanism which matches supply and demand in real-time on the grid)."

How much does Terna pay per hour?

"Actually if you value the contract per hour of fast reserve provided you end up finding that each hour of availability will be paid by Terna EUR29.5 /MW /hour: which is more than three times as much as what is paid in other countries - in France and Germany, current average FCR price is EUR10 /MW /hour.

How did Terna get 230mw?

Terna said the process was participated in by bidders offering six times the amount of capacity being tendered for. The pilot had launched with an expectation that around 230MW would be on offer, Terna received 1,327MW worth of bids, and eventually awarded contracts for 249.9MW.
