Which crystalline silicon photovoltaic cells are excluded from the study?

Also excluded from the scope of the investigation are crystalline silicon photovoltaic cells,not exceeding 10,000 mm2 in surface area,that are permanently integrated into a consumer good whose function is other than power generation and that consumes the electricity generated by the integrated crystalline silicon photovoltaic cell.

Do critical circumstances exist for imports of solar cells from Vietnam?

In accordance with section 703 (e) (1) of the Act,Commerce preliminarily determines that critical circumstances do not exist with respect to imports of solar cells from Vietnam for Boviet Solar Technology Co.,Ltd. (Boviet Solar) and JA Solar Vietnam Company Limited (JAVN).
