

# Energy vault schweiz South Georgia and South Sandwich Islands

How does Swiss Energy Vault work?

The Swiss start-up Energy Vault follows the same principle as pumping and turbines. But instead of water, it uses concrete blocks. When there is a surplus of green electricity, these "bricks" are hoisted on top of each other to form a 120-metre tower. They are then "dropped" using gravity to generate electricity.

Does Energy Vault have a problem?

What is an energy vault tower?

An Energy Vault tower in "discharge" mode, generating electricity to deliver back to the grid. Source: Energy Vault In addition to supplying a flexible reserve of energy to compensate for the intermittency of renewables, the towers have the potential to provide other important ancillary services to maintain grid stability and reliability.

What is Energy Vault renewables?

Source: Energy Vault Renewables harness the power of the sun by extracting energy from the endless stream of solar rays that pound Earth's surface and the winds that course over it. Yet, the sun is often shrouded by clouds (or completely out of sight, at night) and winds ebb and flow.

What happened to South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands?

In 1985, South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands ceased to be administered as a Falkland Islands Dependency and became a separate territory. The King Edward Point base, which had become a small military garrison after the Falklands War, returned to civilian use in 2001 and is now operated by the British Antarctic Survey.
