What is the Solar for Schools scheme?

Minister Foley said, "I am delighted to launch the Solar for Schools scheme. It will allow up to 4,000 schools nationwide to get solar PV panels to reduce their energy bills and their carbon emissions.

What is the new government support for solar panels?

The Minister for the Environment, Climate and Communications, Eamon Ryan TD, has today announced new Government supports of up to EUR2,400 for the installation of solar PV (photovoltaic) panels - for businesses, public organisations and community groups. The new grant scheme will be administered by the SEAI (Sustainable Energy Authority of Ireland).

What's new in the grant support scheme for solar panels?

The Government has approved amendments to the grant support scheme for solar panels. The new range of installation sizes - greater than 6 kWp up to 1,000 kWp (1 MW) capacity - will cover a variety of non-domestic businesses, from small local shops up to large manufacturing facilities.

How many solar installers are there in Ireland?

There are currently 200 Non-domestic solar PV Installers registered with the Sustainable Energy Authority of Ireland and 350 domestic solar PV installers. The Solar for Schools Programme is expected to encourage more companies to enter the installer market.
