How many solar PV projects will greenit build in Italy?

Comprised of eight PV projects,the capacity will be built across three regions in Southern, Central and Northern Italy. GreenIT has signed an agreement with renewables developer Galileo to build eight solar PV projects with a combined capacity of 140MW in Italy.

How many solar PV projects are there in Italy?

Italy currently has 140GWof solar PV projects in its grid connection queue. Image: Juwi In 2023, Italy installed over 5GW of new solar PV generation capacity, by some distance the most since 2011.

How many solar projects will Galileo build in Italy?

In total eight projectswill be built by renewables developer Galileo across three regions in Italy. Image: Andreas Gücklhorn on Unsplash GreenIT, an Italian joint venture by oil group Eni and state lender Cassa Depositi e Prestiti (CDP) Equity, has signed an agreement with renewables developer Galileo to build 140MW of solar PV in Italy.

How much does solar PV cost in Italy?

Spillati said that around 140GW of solar PV projects are currently in the grid connection queue in Italy and that the total queue for all renewables is in excess of 300GW. This,he said,comes down to permitting: "There is no barrier to entry" for projects to get accepted for a connection point,as he claims it currently costs only around EUR3000.

What is a 'largest' solar project financing deal in Italy?


The financing includes a greenfield project finance agreement for two PV plants in Sicily and Sardinia, with a combined capacity of around 200MW. It was agreed in December 2023 and represents one of the "largest solar project financing deals in the Italian market", Sonnedix said.
