Is balancing ESS a problem in Malawi?

In Malawi, balancing the ESSs has been difficult, especially in the inland freshwater shallow lakes' changing catchment (Arthington et al., 2017; Arvine et al., 2016; Makwinja et al., 2021d). Different policies have different priorities and do not account for potential trade-offs and synergies in ESSs.
