How to buy solar panels in Mauritius?

The purchase of solar arrays could be financed through a 'green' loan from commercial banks or a concessional loan from the Development Bank of Mauritius (DBM). Eligible customers for the household solar program will also get benefits from an income tax deduction under the government's Solar Energy Investment Allowance.
