

Why is Moldova imposing a state of emergency?

More than half the world's population sees AP journalism every day. Moldova's parliament has voted in favor of imposing a state of emergency in the energy sector over fears that Russia could leave the European Union candidate country without sufficient natural gas supplies this winter.

Does Moldova have a power plant?

The Kuciurgan power plant, which is crucial for Moldova's electricity supply, is powered by natural gas supplied by Russian energy giant Gazprom. The plant was privatized in 2004 by authorities in Transnistria and later sold to a Russian state-owned company. Moldova does not recognize this privatization. How Dependent on Russia Is Moldova?

How much energy does Moldova use?

Moldova imports 100% of its gas and coal consumption, nearly all of its oil consumption and around 80% of its electricity (including electricity procured from the Moldavskaya GRES [power station] situated in Transnistria). 1 Second, Moldova has obligations stemming from its aspirations for European integration.

What is Moldova's long-term goal in the electricity sector?

In the electricity sector, Moldova's long-term objective was to fully interconnect with the European Network of Transmission System Operators for Electricity (ENTSO-E). This was achieved significantly earlier than planned, due to Russia's invasion of Ukraine in late February 2022.

How is Moldova implementing the Third Energy Package 3?

Moldova has successfully adopted several legislative acts, which transpose the EU's Third Energy Package 3 at the level of primary legislation; related secondary legislation is also being developed and partially adopted.

What drives the energy policy agenda of the Republic of Moldova (Moldova)?

The energy policy agenda of the Republic of Moldova (Moldova) is driven by several interrelated factors. The first key driver is high dependence on imports from limited sources and subsequent energy security considerations.
