Where is Mongolia located?

Mongolia: Gobi Desert Camels in a patch of vegetation in the Gobi Desert, southern Mongolia. Mongolia, historically Outer Mongolia, landlocked country located in north-central Asia. It is roughly oval in shape, measuring 1,486 miles (2,392 km) from west to east and, at its maximum, 782 miles (1,259 km) from north to south.

Is Mongolia a landlocked country?

Mongolia is the world's largest landlocked country that does not border a closed sea, and much of its area is covered by grassy steppe, with mountains to the north and west and the Gobi Desert to the south. Ulaanbaatar, the capital and largest city, is home to roughly half of the country's population.

Who speaks Mongolian?

It is spoken by ethnic Mongols and other closely related Mongolic peoples who are native to modern Mongolia and surrounding parts of East and North Asia. Mongolian is the official language of Mongolia and Inner Mongolia and a recognized language of Xinjiang and Qinghai.

How many people live in Mongolia?

There are 2,791,272 people living in Mongolia. The country is the 18th biggest country in the world, with an area of 1,564,116 km² (603,909 sq mi). Mongolia is mainly rural with the lowest population density of all independent countries in the world. [note 1] The area which is Mongolia has been ruled by various nomadic empires.

What does Mongolia mean?

The name Mongolia means the "Land of the Mongols" in Latin. The Mongolian word "Mongol" (mongol) is of uncertain etymology.

How big is Mongolia?

At 1,564,116 km² (603,909 sq mi), Mongolia is the world's 18th-largest country. [46] It is significantly larger than the next-largest country, Peru. It mostly lies between latitudes 41° and 52°N (a small area is north of 52°), and longitudes 87° and 120°E.
