

Where is San Marino located?

San Marino is surrounded by Italy in Southern Europe,i.e. almost completely by the province of Rimini in the region of Emilia Romagna and,only on a stretch of about three kilometres in the south,by the province of Pesaro and Urbino in the Marche region. San Marino lies about ten kilometres (six miles) from the Adriatic coast at Rimini.

Where is San Marino shrine?

San Marino Shrine (???????) is a shrine in Serravalle,Republic of San Marino. It is the first official shinto shrine in Europe supported by the Jinja Honcho when the shrine was established. Manlio Cadero [ja]planned the construction of the shrine in consultation with the Jinja Honcho.

What is San Marino famous for?

The temple is surrounded by numerous rows of vines, set against the backdrop of the Mediterranean mountains and landscapes. The Shrine of San Marino is consecrated to the kami Amaterasu, who in the Shinto pantheon personifies the deity of the Sun, the primary source of life on Earth.

Who is the Shinto priest of San Marino shrine?

The Miyazukasa (chief Shinto priest) of the San Marino Shrine is Francesco Brigante(????????????????),who received his Shinto priesthood status from the Shinto Shrine Honcho and was appointed as chief priest in 2013 and awarded the Bushido honour . He is a local San Marino hotel owner who trained at Yudonosan Shrine in Yamagata Prefecture.

How old is San Marino?

The world's oldest sovereign state,it dates from the fourth century AD. Atop the center of this hilly area's highest point,Mount Titano,is the capital city of San Marino. Medieval stone walls enclose the original settlement,built entirely of stone and closed to traffic.

What is the climate like in San Marino?

The climate of San Marino is temperate,with quite cold winters and warm to hot summers. The small Republic of San Marino is located between Marche and Emilia-Romagna,two regions of north-central Italy. The altitude varies from 55 meters (180 feet) in the north-east to 749 meters (2,457 ft) on the top of Mount Titano.
