Is there solar power in Myanmar?

Myanmar has high solar irradiation levels in many areas,but no large-scale solar power systems have been installeddue to the largely mountainous terrain,protected areas,and limited grid system. Solar power is currently an option only for rural and off-grid applications in Myanmar.

What are photovoltaics used for in Myanmar?

In rural areas of Myanmar, photovoltaics are used for charging batteries and pumping water. Approximately 70% of Myanmar's population of 50 million live in rural areas. Myanmar opened its first solar power plant in Minbu, Magway Division, in November 2018.

Is Myanmar a good place to invest in solar power?

According to a study on solar resources and solar PV potential in Myanmar conducted by the World Bank,most of the population (75%-85%) lives within a 25-50 km radius of HV power lines,making it a promising location for medium- and large-scale solar projects. In 2017,peak demand reached ~3000 MW.
