How much does a 5 kilowatt solar system cost?

The average 5-kilowatt (kW) solar panel system is \$14,210 before considering any financial incentives. Ultimately many factors figure into the price per watt of a solar system, but the average cost is typically as low as \$2.75 per watt. This price will vary if a project requires special adders like ground mounting, a main panel upgrade, an EV charger, etc.

Less efficient polycrystalline panels are typically cheaper at \$0.75 per watt, putting the price of a 400-watt panel at \$300. The cost of a solar panel also depends on how you buy it.
