

Is Sweden a planetary system?

Get ready for the most peculiar road trip that will help you understand the vastness and emptiness of the solar system--and Sweden. The Sweden Solar System is the world's largest model of our planetary system, at a scale of 1:20 million. The sun is represented by the Globe Arena in Stockholm, the largest spherical building in the world.

Where is the 'Sweden Solar System' located?

The "Sweden Solar System" is the world's largest model of the solar system, with the Avicci Arena (globo) in Stockholm representing the sun. The inner planets line up northward in Greater Stockholm, with Mercury located in the City Museum, Venus in the Royal Institute of Technology, Earth in the Museum of Natural History and Mars in Mörby Centrum.

How many planets are in the Sweden Solar System?

Originally conceived as the Stockholm Solar System with planets no further than Jupiter, the idea was soon taken up by schools, science institutions, and other organizations further afield. The Sweden Solar System currently consists of more than 60 objects distributed across 26 locations in Sweden.

What is the Stockholm Solar System?

In fact, interest in the project developed to the point that the first 'S' in its acronym soon had to be given a new meaning. The Stockholm Solar System became the Sweden Solar System: a planetary project on a national scale, which, like our understanding of our little corner of the galaxy, has steadily grown over the years.

Is Sweden the world's largest planetary system?

Unbeknownst to most visitors, the country is home to the world's largest permanent model of the planetary system known as The Swedish Solar System but often - as below - called Sweden Solar System, which is a bit odd if you ask me. Okay, there's a little artistic licence used here, I will admit!

Does Sweden have a solar system?

The Sweden Solar System--probably also the world's largest scale model per se--makes full use of the country's vastness. If there is one thing Sweden has plenty of, it is space. At 172,752 square miles (447,425 square kilometers), it is Europe's fifth-largest country (after Russia, Ukraine, France, and Spain).

The Sweden Solar System currently consists of more than 60 objects distributed across 26 locations in Sweden. The latest to be added are the dwarf planet Varda and its moon Ilmaris; in Uddevalla in September 2021.
