

Is Moldova joining the International Solar Alliance?

New Delhi: Moldova has joined the International Solar Alliance, the Ministry of External Affairs spokesperson, Randhir Jaiswal said on Monday. Jaiswal said that India welcomes Moldova in its efforts to promote sustainability. The agreement was signed between External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar and Moldovan Deputy Prime Minister Mihai Popsoi.

Why did Moldova launch its first wind and solar power plant?

CHISINAU, Aug 16 (Reuters) - Moldova launched its first tender for wind and solar power plants on Friday as part of a push to reduce its reliance on Russian energy. "Opening up for investors to develop renewables is yet another critical step towards ensuring greater energy security for Moldova," Energy Minister Victor Parlicov told Reuters.

How does Moldova share energy data?

Moldova shares energy data through five annual International Energy Agency (IEA)/Eurostat/UN Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE) joint questionnaires.

How much energy does Moldova use in 2023?

Official data shows Moldova increased the share of renewable energy sources in its electricity consumption to 10.5% in 2023 from 3.6% in 2021, driven by wind and solar. Officials said the total installed capacity was around 400 MW at the end of the second quarter of 2024.

What is the main energy source in Moldova?

Natural gas accounts for more than half of Moldova's total primary energy supply (53% in 2018), oil roughly a quarter (23% in 2018) and solid biomass one-fifth (19% in 2018). Most natural gas is used for electricity and heat generation, whereas oil is the most important energy source for final consumers.
