If approved, the solar farm is expected to support urban expansion in the north of Kuwait, as well as to reduce the price for electricity production in the country and create about 2,000 new jobs related to the construction and operation of the facility.

Will Kuwait produce 15 percent of its power from solar and wind?

Ali: The late Amir Sheikh Sabah Al-Ahmad Al-Jaber Al-Sabah announced at the 2012 United Nations Conference on Climate Change that Kuwait will strive to produce 15 percent of its power from solar and wind by 2030,a goal that has since been reaffirmed in the New Kuwait 2035 vision.

The Kuwait Authority for Partnership Projects (KAPP) has launched a tender to build a 1,100 MW solar project in Al-Shaqaya, Al-Jahra Governorate, near Kuwait City. The KAAP said that project developers will have to hold at least a 15% stake in the submitted projects.
