

What is the Solomon Islands solar power development project?

The Asian Development Bank (ADB) has approved financing to support the conversion of electricity networks in five provinces of the Solomon Islands almost entirely to solar power; with the assistance of battery storage. The Solar Power Development Project will see grid-connected solar farms constructed in Kirakira, Lata, Malu'u, Munda, and Tulagi.

The Project forms part of a broader initiative of Solomon Islands Electricity Authority (SIEA), trading as Solomon Power, the state-owned enterprise responsible for energy generation and distribution within the Solomon Islands. Solomon Power has recently started to invest in strengthening and expanding its system.

It is part of a broader programme by Solomon Power to expand electricity access to rural communities through renewable energy-based grids. ADB is providing a USD-2.24-million grant for the project, which will also be funded by a USD-6.2-million grant from the Strategic Climate Fund and USD 6.76 million from the government of Solomon Islands.

The Solomon Islands government has set a 50% renewable energy use for power generation by 2020 to be achieved through its Tina Hydro Development Project and the Savo Geothermal projects, both developments to be commissioned by the end of 2017.---Rural Households Electrification Targets: Diesel self-generation 5% in 2015 5% in 2020, 3% in 2030.

The project will be the first solar power project in Solomon Islands to install battery storage, which will allow electricity to be stored from the sun during the day to power the provincial towns at night. The project will reduce the need for costly shipments of diesel to the provincial centers.

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
