Who is mpuma power?

Mpuma Power was founded in 2023 in South Africa by Mark Shorrock. How much power does South Africa need?

Estimates suggest that South Africa needs around 6,000MW of extra capacity to overcome the current deficit. The following sections explain why I predict it is likely to require as long as five years to eradicate this shortfall, though partial improvement should already be felt by the end of 2024.

How many power cuts did South Africa experience in 2022?

By the end of 2022, South Africans experienced more than 200 days of power cuts, the most in a calendar year to date. Load shedding stages by hour in 2023.

Should South Africa switch to a low-carbon energy system?

Today, large renewable energy battery systems are seen as the best future option for storing renewable power with South Africa's state-owned electricity company, Eskom, beginning to set up battery storage. Several factors complicate South Africa's transition to a low-carbon energy system.

Why is South Africa in a power crisis?

South Africa is in the middle of a severe electricity crisis, with enforced power cuts that have worsened every year. Electricity is sometimes unavailable for 10 hours a day. The shortfall is the consequence of frequent breakdowns at its ageing coal power plants, which constitute 74% of the country's generating capacity.

How long does a power outage last in South Africa?

With areas experiencing power outages typically lasting two to four hours. Although South Africa has a national grid some areas of the country experience more periods of loadshedding than other areas due to differences in local power generation capabilities and difficulties in electrical distribution.
