President-elect Trump and his team likely noticed how Turkish policies reversed years of Iranian investments in Syria within just four days.

Why did Russia call Turkey an occupying force in Syria?

A few days later, Russia labeled Turkey as an occupying force in Syria. It demanded the withdrawal of Turkish military personnel from Syria, called for an end to Turkish support for the Syrian opposition, and stated that a meeting between Erdogan and Assad was not feasible at this time.

Is Turkey an occupying force in Syria?

Following the last Astana summit--attended by Turkey, Iran, and Russia in November--the Russian special envoy to Syria, Alexander Lavrentiev, expressed strong opposition to any Turkish cross-border military operations against the YPG. A few days later, Russia labeled Turkey as an occupying force in Syria.

Did Turkey take the driving seat in Syria during the Nagorno-Karabakh War?

Unlike its decisive role during the Nagorno-Karabakh war, where Turkey provided both the strategic military mind and critical equipment to Azerbaijani forces against Armenian troops, Ankara did not take the driving seat in Syria. HTS seized the initiative and recast the balance of power. Turkey's old playbook no longer applies.

Can Turkey anchor itself in a reconstructed Syria?

Managing refugee returns or fostering local livelihoods might help Turkey anchor itself in a reconstructed Syria. But this demands a delicate equilibrium--one that accepts a pluralistic tapestry of groups and interests. Diplomats, strategists, and investors now watch for signals.
