What type of power sockets are available in the Turks and Caicos Islands?

Does TCU have a license in Grand Turk & Salt Cay?

TCU operates pursuant to a 50-year license in Grand Turk and Salt Cay that also expires in 2036. FortisTCI also holds 25-year supplier licenses granted in 2012 for the cays between Providenciales and North Caicos (except Parrot Cay), East Caicos and adjacent cays and inlets.

What is fcti & TCU generating capacity?

FTCI and TCU have a combined diesel-fired generating capacity of 90.7 MW. In 2019, the companies met a combined peak demand of 42.6 MW. The companies own more than 600 circuit kilometers of transmission and distribution lines across the islands, and together they operate four vertically integrated electricity systems.
