



ASPILSAN Energy, a cell battery manufacturer in T&#252;rkiye's Kayseri province, has signed a technology transfer agreement with its South Korean partners in December 2020 to develop lithium-ion cell batteries in T&#252;rkiye.

Turkey has become an entry point into the European market for EV battery companies and other tech companies from China.

In 2019, Togg and Farasis formed a joint venture named SIRO, each taking a 50% stake, to build a battery plant in Gebze, Turkey, that will produce lithium-ion batteries to power Togg's electric cars. Farasis is not the only Chinese tech company making its way into Turkey.
