

Will a Vatican solar project be built outside Rome?

In an apostolic letter, the pontiff said the project will be constructed on Vatican-owned property outside of Rome that spans 424 hectares, adding capacity to existing solar panel installations in the city state.

How can Vatican City achieve climate neutrality?

A. Where is Vatican Radio located?

Located on the edge of Rome, the 424-hectare site houses the transmission facilities for Vatican Radio, thanks to a 1951 agreement between the Holy See and the Italian State. The new plant is intended to supply the energy needs of Vatican Radio and contribute to "the complete energy sustenance of Vatican City State."

In *Fratello Sole*, Pope Francis roots the decision to embrace solar power in his own invitation "to all mankind," in the encyclical *Laudato si'*, to make lifestyle changes to counter global warming and the "pervasive" use of fossil fuels.
