

Where is Venezuela located in South America?

Venezuela, country located at the northern end of South America. It occupies a roughly triangular area that is larger than the combined areas of France and Germany. Venezuela is bounded by the Caribbean Sea and the Atlantic Ocean to the north, Guyana to the east, Brazil to the south, and Colombia to the southwest and west.

Is Venezuela a country?

Venezuela, [c] officially the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela, [d] is a country on the northern coast of South America, consisting of a continental landmass and many islands and islets in the Caribbean Sea. It comprises an area of 916,445 km² (353,841 sq mi), and its population was estimated at 29 million in 2022. [18]

How many states are in Venezuela?

Venezuela is divided into 23 states (estados), a capital district (distrito capital) corresponding to the city of Caracas, and the Federal Dependencies (Dependencias Federales, a special territory). Venezuela is further subdivided into 335 municipalities (municipios); these are subdivided into over one thousand parishes (parroquias).

Is Venezuela a 'undemocratic' country?

An election dismissed by independent observers as 'undemocratic' has thrown Venezuela into turmoil. Hundreds of demonstrators have been detained following Venezuela's disputed presidential election. Under pressure to back up claims he won the election, President Maduro turns to the country's top court.

What is the capital of Venezuela?

The national capital, Caracas, is Venezuela's primary centre of industry, commerce, education, and tourism. Venezuela administers a number of Caribbean islands and archipelagos, among which are Margarita Island, La Blanquilla, La Tortuga, Los Roques, and Los Monjes.

How is Venezuela connected to the world?

Venezuela is connected to the world primarily via air (Venezuela's airports include the Simón Bolívar International Airport in Maiquetía, near Caracas and La Chinita International Airport near Maracaibo) and sea (with major seaports at La Guaira, Maracaibo and Puerto Cabello).
